

# The Great Chesapeake Bay Swim 4.4 and 1 Mile Bay Challenge Conducted Sunday, June 12, 2022 

 POST SWIM OVERVIEW - Saturday, June 18, 2022 57 Pier One Rd., Bay Bridge Marina, Eastern Shores of the Twin Bridges Exit 37 S. off Rt. 50, Pier One Road, Stevensville, MD 21666Despite threatening lightening-thunder storms up and down the east coast, GCBS took place as planned. On time, in safety with all swimmers accounted for from start to finish, both the One Mile Bay Challenge and the 4.4 Miles Bay swim. We received a major break from a very large storm cell which missed our location.
"The race starts from the shores of Sandy Point State Park, which is about 5 miles northeast of Annapolis. The course extends eastward between the two spans of the William Preston Lane, Jr., Memorial Bridge (U.S. Highway 50) and finishes at a small sandy beach on Kent Island immediately south of the Bridge eastern-shore."

The 4.4 started from the Annapolis side of the twin bridges at Sandy Point State Park. Two waves of swimmers, swam back to the finish beach next to the bridges in Stevensville, MD. The previous swim was conducted in 2019, which also proved to be a very challenging event day.

The 1 Mile Bay Challenge started and finished in Stevensville at the Marina beach area, next to the twin bridges. The same beach was utilized by the 4.4 swim for their 4.4 finish.

Kudos to all 2022 swimmers, who first had to meet 4.4 entry requirements, and train during a very difficult weather/Covid-19 time period.

You all did it . . . all winners! Until next June, for the love of the sport and the always exciting, and challenging Great Chesapeake Bay Swim 2023.

## THE SWIMMERS: 6/12/2022

This year, GCBS had the largest contingent of competitive youth swimmers. 13 to 19 years old. I communicated, one-on-one, with each of their parents/guardians to be assured as to the level of training/experience. Their documentation was submitted by either their team swim coach, or directly by their parents. All had representation at their swim packet check-in. Many are first timers.

Your selected Swim Wave was entry-form selected, by each entrants. It was a question within your entry form. Your wave assignment was according to your entry form selection. LINMARK does not select your wave assignments:

Wave 1 Selection: predicting you would finish OVER two hours.
Wave $\mathbf{2}$ Selection: predicting you would finish UNDER two hours.
4.4 wave start times were 15 minutes apart. Note: the program times you from when LINMARK actually starts our time machine, at each wave's start. The time gap between waves is removed by the timing process, and now reflects that all swimmers started at the same time. All then merged to reflect same start times : overall finish times, regardless of wave start time differentials.

The One-Mile Swimmers were assigned to their wave according to their completed swim-entry form and feepayment date. The only One-mile Swim Requirement, was to finish a one mile open-water swim within 40 minutes. No swim documentation required. 100 Entrants per wave, according to the date of their processed entry form with the required fee.

Completed-past . . . 2022 GCBS swim results (which we have on record) is a permitted 4.4 documentation submission. It is required to be within two years of the current 4.4 swim date. (Thanks to COVID-19, of course, that time frame, for this year's swim, was just about non-existent.)

Swim documentation, either from a past event, or a 1.5 k distance - from the swim portion of a triathlon or a single competitive swim, is also permitted. If none of the above were available, LINMARK had a Witnessed 3Mile Pool swim form, posted for entrants to either download or mail directly to LINMARK Sports . . . witnessed, signed . . . It was the applicant's responsibility to submit the completed form.

Specific, additional event requirements were all available and detailed, by utilizing the MORE INFO. Drop-down menus listing of all info./instructional pages. (This and additional drop-down options were available at the top of GCBS 2022 event page. Unfortunately, this year, all 4.4 swimmers were mandatory required to submit 4.4 swim documentation to LINMARK Sports. You all, were not happy campers over this swim requirement.


Let's look at some of our awesome swimmers, whether they could or could not finish the distance:

1. Our youngest newbie youth swimmer was Ms. Lorelei Schmidt, $\mathbf{1 3}$ yrs old, from NC - she finished in 2:09:47, first in her age division, and 120 overall among male \& female finishers field. Awesome! (She was a lottery selected entrant. I hesitated to accept her, until speaking with her parents and received her coach's submitted documentation.) (a proven dolphin)
